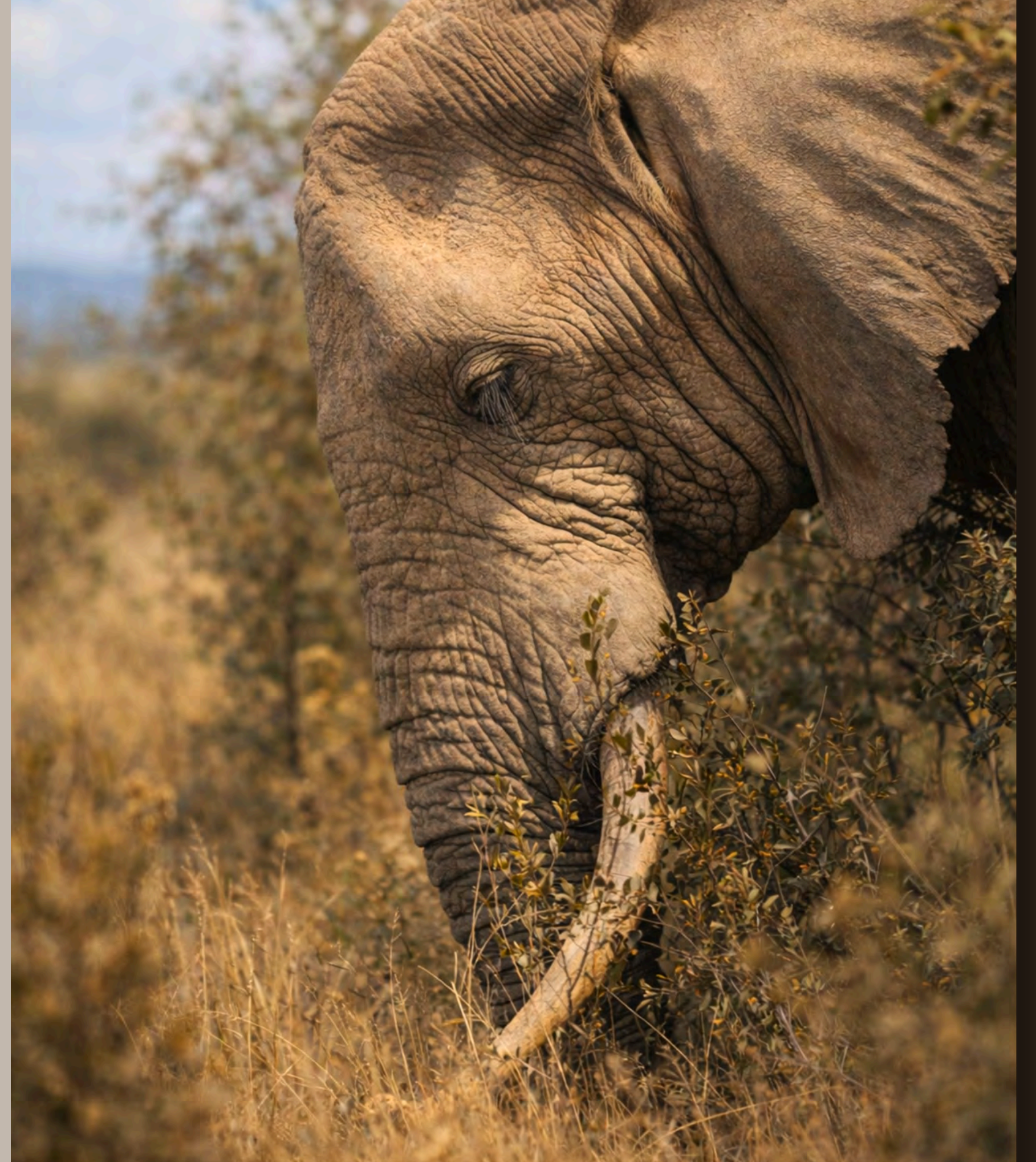

The Waterberg Biosphere, where Royal Morubisi is situated, is a UNESCO-recognised area renowned for its biodiversity and conservation efforts. The Kaingo Private Game Reserve, where the lodge resides, is part of a larger conservation initiative that aims to protect wildlife, particularly endangered species, through sustainable practices.

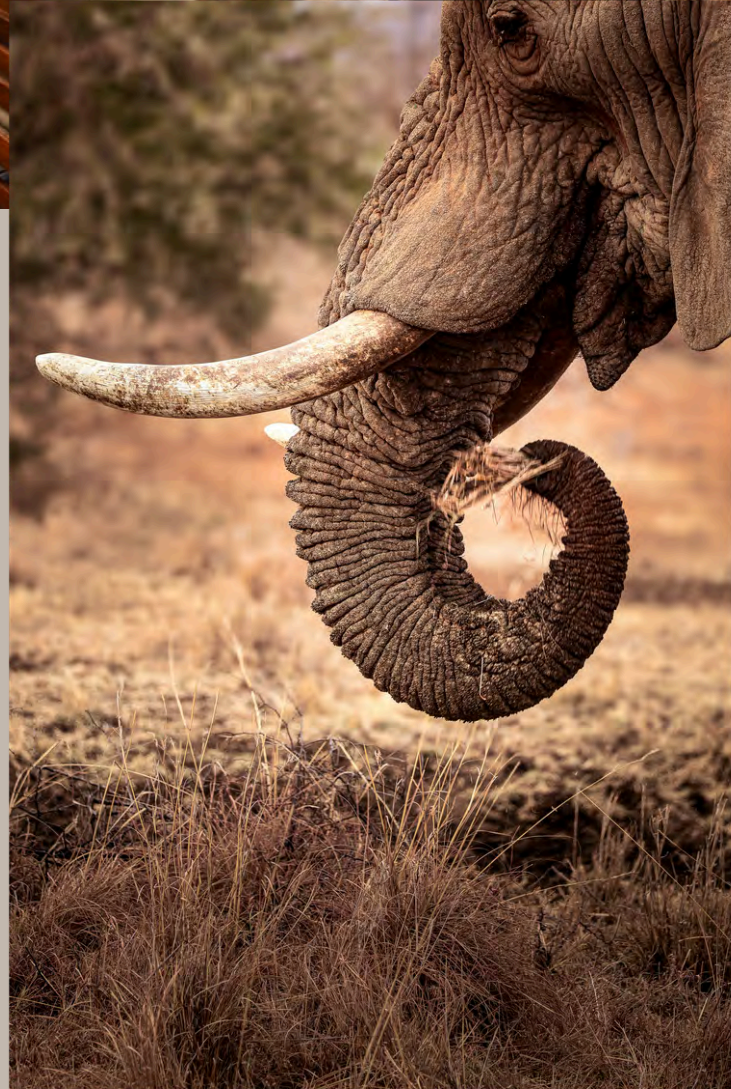
Kaingo is home to a wide range of ecosystems, from bushveld to riverine forests. Conservation efforts within the reserve focus on habitat restoration, anti-poaching initiatives, and the sustainable management of natural resources, ensuring the protection of its rich biodiversity for generations to come.

The Kaingo Reserve offers some of the best wildlife encounters in the region. Visitors can expect to see the Big Five (lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo, and rhino) alongside a plethora of other species, such as giraffes, zebras, wildebeests, and a variety of antelope. Birdwatchers will also be delighted with over 300 species of birds present in the area. The reserve's untouched wilderness provides the perfect backdrop for close-up wildlife experiences, whether through guided game drives or walking safaris. Night drives offer a chance to witness nocturnal animals in their natural habitat, adding an extra layer of adventure to your safari experience.

Stay fit and active with a variety of modern equipment in the lodge's fitness center



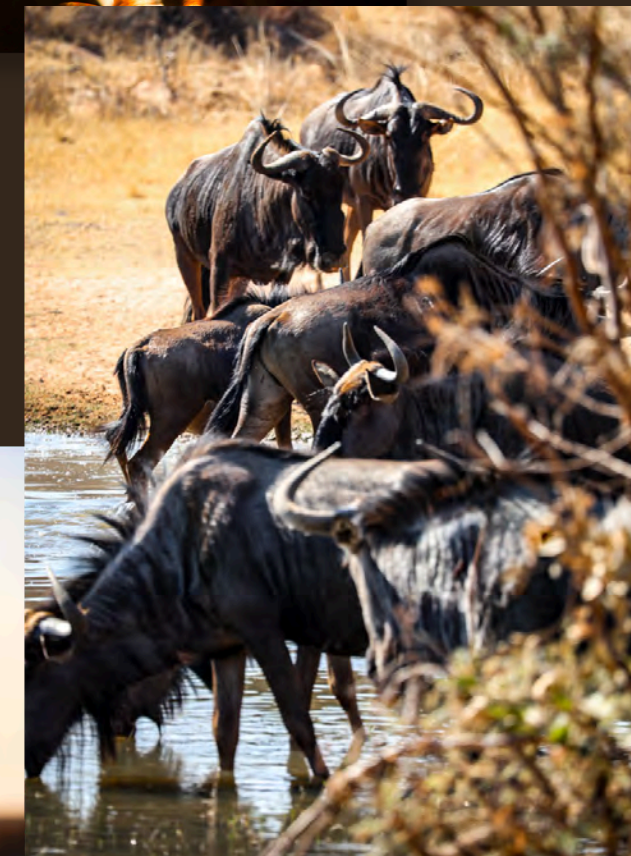
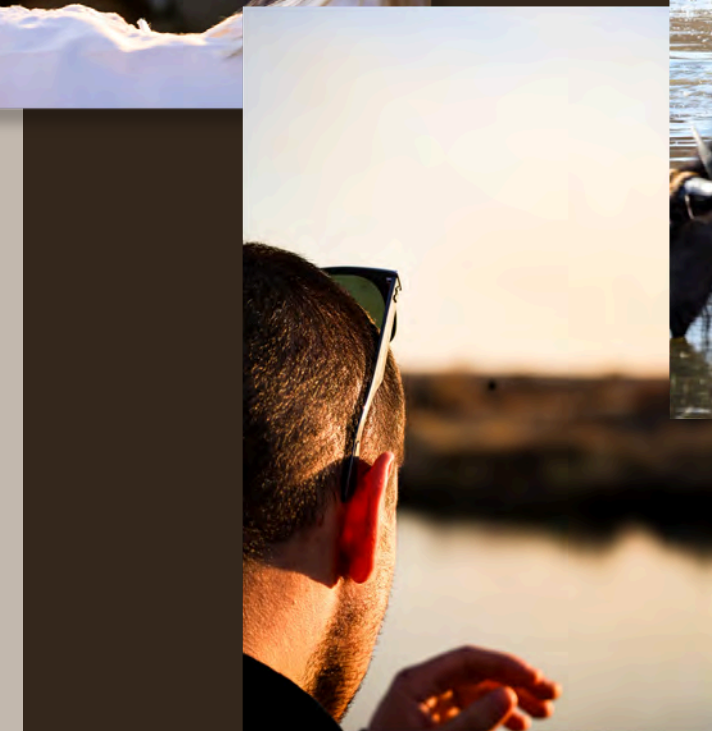
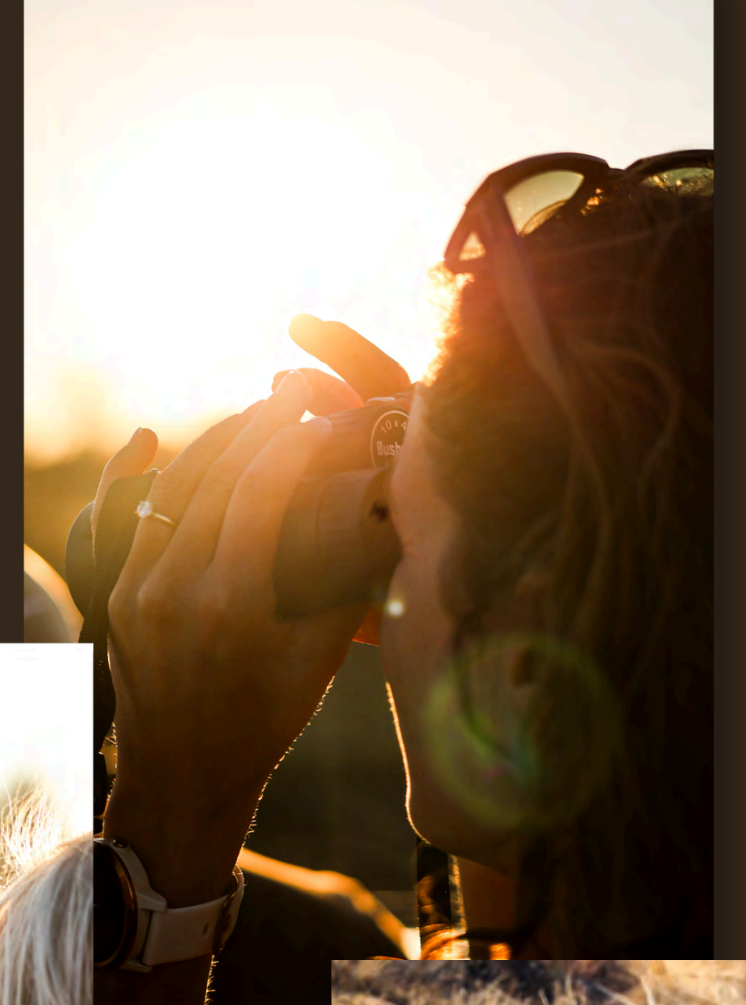
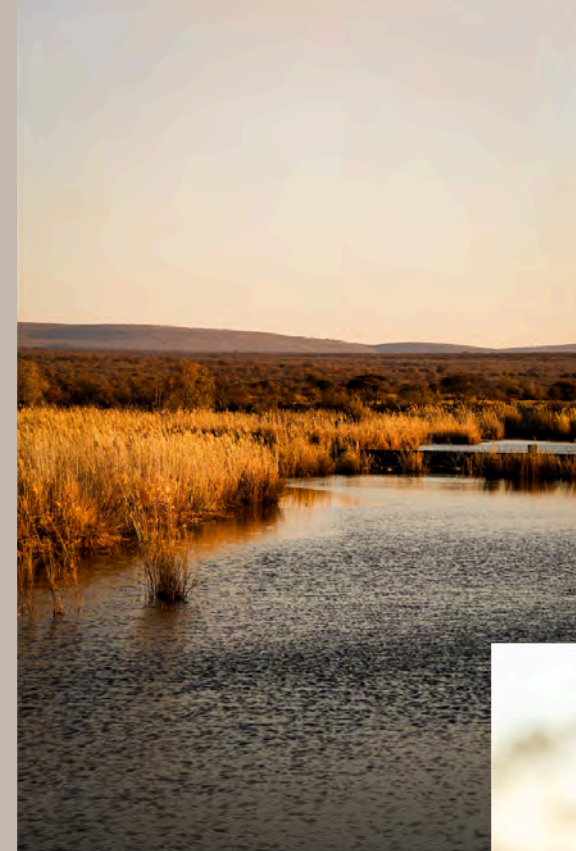

FOUNDERS LODGE

Royal Morubisi Founders Lodge features luxury suites and one exclusive Leopard House, all inspired by African wildlife themes. Nestled among tall, shady trees, each suite is designed with understated elegance, earthy colours, leather, and dark wood finishes, offering air conditioning for ultimate comfort.

The lodge's expansive natural garden, complete with winding paths connecting the suites to the main lodge, merges seamlessly with the surrounding bushveld savanna. The nearby waterhole draws a variety of birds and antelope, enhancing the tranquil, nature-filled experience.

CONSERVATION

We have adopted a holistic approach, laying the groundwork for long-term ecological and economic viability, and creating a model of conservation supported by ecotourism. Kaingo represents an opportunity to explore not just a landscape, but a new model of conservation. Kaingo's solid conservation ethic coupled with a very limited lodge footprint sets it apart from high traffic reserves where there is an ever-increasing conflict between conservation and economic objectives.
